

The Project of the Provision of Medical Equipment for Blood-related Diseases to Fatimid Foundation (2015)



Due to the spread of Thalassemia and Hemophilia (Blood-diseases) around Pakistan, there is a continuous requirement for fresh and safe blood transfusion. However, these blood treatments are too expensive for underprivileged people. An NGO, "Fatimid Foundation" has worked for free blood treatment for those people in Karachi, Pakistan. However, the treatment has not been sufficient for all the patients, because of the lack of medical equipment. Considering this situation, KUSANONE (GPP) grant assistance provided the blood-related diseases medical equipment to Fatimid Foundation. As a result, there is an improvement in the medical services, and it has become possible to accept additional 10,800 people in a year. Thus, more people are receiving blood-treatment for free.
