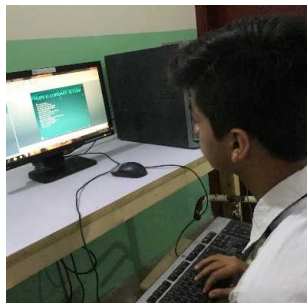


The Project for Expansion of HOPE Formal School and Vocational Training Center at Korangi in Karachi (2013)



An NGO, HOPE (Health Oriented Preventive Education Foundation) runs a school to provide education for underprivileged children as well as a vocational training for women at Korangi, Karachi. However, due to the increasing number of children, the school were not able to accommodate them. Thus, school had no choice but to decline new students enrollment. Considering this situation, the school building was extended through KUSANONE (GGP) grant assistance and provided with sewing equipment to enhance the vocational training capacity as well. As a result, the school accommodate 602 students now. In this way, a number of children and women have received better educational opportunities.
