

The Project for Installation of Seven Water Filtration Plants in Karachi (2011)



Since drinking water is contaminated with industrial wastewater, estimated 30,000 people are dying every year in Karachi, Pakistan. An NGO, “Al-Khidumat Foundation” has been working towards welfare services in Pakistan and provided Water Filtration Plants and installed at 7 spots in Karachi city through KUSANONE (GGP) grant assistance. As a result, it has achieved approximately 2 million users in a year and has been providing clean water for local people. In addition, a user pays a minimal amount to the NGO, thus they receive the water with very low price. This also helps in collecting money that is utilized for facility maintenance. This maintenance system generates the sustainable cycle.
