"Specified Skilled Workers" Memorandum for Cooperation Signed

Ambassador MATSUDA Kuninori, and Federal Secretary of the Ministry of Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development, Mr Aamir Hasan, signed the Memorandum for Cooperation (MOC) regarding the "Specified Skilled Worker" at a signing ceremony held on 28 December 2019. H.E. Mr. SONOURA Kentaro, Special Advisor for Foreign Affairs to President ABE Shinzo of the Liberal Democratic Party of Japan (LDP), and H.E. Mr. Zulfi Bukhari, SPAM, witnessed the signing of MOC.

JAPAN FEST 2019 IN KARACHI

The program of Japan Fest 2019 started with the Soran Bushi dance performed by the Karachi Japanese School, followed by a jiu-jutsu demonstration by the Pakistan Jiu-Jutsu Federation. The results of the art competition "Yoshi's Iron Pencil Tournament" were announced thereafter. This was followed by a wadai-ko (Japanese drums) performance presented by the Consulate staffs led by Deputy Consul-General Katsunori Ashida. The penultimate act was a Japan-Pakistan fusion fashion show in collaboration with the Indus Valley School of Art and Architecture, which showcased apparel designs from both cultures.

The main event of the evening was an enthralling performance by a Japanese orchestral triplet known as The Trio Zipang, comprised of Mr. Ayumu Takanabe on percussion; alto saxophone player Ms. Naomi Tabata, and Ms. Emi Kitagawa in the piano. Consul-General of Japan Mr. ISOMURA Toshikazu expresses his appreciation for the frequency of cultural interactions between Japan and Pakistan.

























عالمی سینما میں شہرت کی بلندیوں کوچھونے والے جاپانی فلم سازوں میں سے ایک معتبرنام'' آکیرا کوروساوا'' کا ہے، جن کوہم جدید جاپانی فلمی صنعت کا'' بابا ہے سینما''
مجھی کہد سکتے ہیں۔انہوں نے مصوری سے اپنے فنی سفر کی ابتدا کی ،آگے چل کرییشوق فلم سازی کے مشلے میں بدل گیا۔ان کی فلموں کے لیے کہا جاتا ہے، وہ فلموں میں مشہور سینما فریم سیٹ کرنے کی بجائے منظر کوسیٹ کرتے تھے،ان کا بنایا ہوا فریم کوئی پینٹنگ ہی محسوس ہوتا ، بیخو بی ان کی اکثر فلموں میں دیکھی بھی جاسکتی ہے، بیان کی مشہور سینما کوئی بینٹنگ ہی میں سے بھی ایک تھی ،جس کے لیے وہ عالمی طور پرشہرت یا فتہ ہیں۔

40 کی دہائی میں دوسری جنگ عظیم اپنے انجام کو بہنچ رہی تھی اور'' آکیراکوروساوا''بطور ہدایت کارفلمی صنعت میں اپنے کیرئیرکا آغاز کررہے تھے۔انہوں نے تقریباً چھ دہائیوں میں 20سے زائدفلموں کی ہدایت کاری کی جبکہ 80 کے قریب فلموں کے اسکر پٹ کھے، جن میں زیادہ ترفلموں میں انہیں کامیابی ہی حاصل ہوئی ۔ 25 فلموں میں تقریباً نائب ہدایت کاری کے فرائض بھی انجام دیے۔ 17 فلمیں پروڈیوس کیں اور 11 فلموں کی ایڈیٹنگ کا کام بھی خود کیا۔ایک آدھ فلم کی موسیقی مرتب کرنے میں بھی شامل رہے،اس طرح فلم کی سائنس کو اپنے آرٹ میں ملا کرفلم بینوں کے لیے سینما اسکرین پرجیران کن منظر نامہ پیش کیا۔

''آ کیرا کوروساوا''اسکر پٹ رائننگ اور ہدایت کاری کےعلاوہ ایڈیٹنگ سمیت فلم کے دیگر شعبوں میں بھی مہارت رکھتے تھے، یہی وجبھی ، وہ فلم کے تمام مراحل سے بخو بی واقف تھے۔ 1990 میں زندگی بھر کی فلمی خدمات کے سلسلے میں لائف اچیومنٹ کا اعزازی آسکرابوارڈ دیا گیا۔ ہالی ووڈ میں آج کے کئی نامور ہدایت کاروں، جن میں اسٹیون اسپیل برگ اور دیگر شامل ہیں۔وہ انہیں اپنا استاد بھی مانتے ہیں۔

آج بھی ہالی ووڈ میں ان کی فلموں کے اثرات دیکھے جاسکتے ہیں، جن میں معروف مثال معروف امریکی فلم سیریز''اسٹار وارز'' کی ہے، جس کا مرکزی خیال'' آگیرا کورو ساوا کی فلم'' دی ہڈن فورٹریس'' سے اخذ کیا گیا۔'' آگیرا کورو ساوا'' کی تاریخ پیدائش 23 مارچ 1910 ہے، وہ جاپان کے شہرٹو کیو میں پیدا ہوئے جبکہ 6 ستمبر 1998 کواسی شہر میں ان کی تدفین ہوئی۔88 سال کی عمر پائی۔ایشیائی فلمی ہدایت کاروں میں ایران کے مشہور ترین فلم ساز''عباس کیار شمی' جبکہ انڈیا سے تعلق رکھنے والے معروف بڑگا کی فلم ساز''متیا جیت رائے'' بھی دوستانہ مراسم تھے۔

دوسری جنگ عظیم کے زمانے میں بید ہدایت کاری کے کیرئیرکوکامیاب کرنے کے لیے شدید محنت کررہے تھے اورانہی دنوں شادی کے بندھن میں بھی بند ھے۔اس شعبے میں ان کے استاد کانام'' کا جیرویا موتو' تھا، جن سے انہوں نے سینما کا شعور لیا۔ ان کی بہترین دس فلمیں جن کوتصور کیا جاتا ہے، ان میں سے''سیون سمورائی'' کوایک جداگانہ اور ممتاز حیثیت حاصل ہے، دیگر فلموں میں اِکیرو، ران ، راشومون ، یوجیمو ، ہائی اینڈلو، دی بیڈسلیپ ویل ، تھرون آف بلڈ ،اسٹر سے ڈوگ اور ریڈ بریڈ ہیں۔ وہ پہلے خود مغربی سینما سے متاثر ہوئے اور اپنے کام سے اسی مغربی سینما کومتاثر بھی کیا۔

امریکا اور جاپان میں ان کے نام کے اعزازات نئے فلم سازوں کودیے جاتے ہیں۔ان کے نام سے قائم'' آگیرا کوروساوا فاؤنڈیشن' کے تحت ایک امریکی جامعہ کے فلم اسکول میں ان کے فن کے حوالے سے تعلیم و تدریس کا سلسلہ بھی جاری ہے۔نسل درنسل مقبولیت سمیٹنے والے اس فلم ساز کا نام عالمی سینما کے روثن ماتھے پر سنہری حروف بن کرزندہ رہےگا۔




