

The Project for the Provision of Medical Equipment for Jam-e-Shafa Clinic in Quetta



Jam-e-Shafa Clinic has been providing medical services to local and refugees communities in the city of Quetta, Balochistan for 34 years. Many of the patients are underprivileged women and children, who are provided with free medical services. The clinic operates 24 hours a day and receives about 6,000 patients monthly, providing treatment for malnutrition, infections, maternal and child health care, vaccinations and other medical needs.
