Certificate Awarding Ceremony for Japanese Language Course Students

On September 25, 2013, Certificate Awarding Ceremony for Japanese Language Course students was held at Japan Information and Cultural Center of the Consulate-General of Japan at Karachi. Twenty-seven Pakistani students have successfully passed their exams and completed their first-term courses which were held from April 15 to September 24, 2013.

Mr. Akira Ouchi, Consul-General of Japan in Karachi, in his speech emphasized that it is very encouraging to see Pakistani people, especially the youths, having keen interest in studying Japanese language.
