

Japanese Parliamentary Vice-Minister's visit to Karachi

Japanese Parliamentary Vice-Minister for Foreign Affairs Minoru Kiuchi paid an official visit to Karachi from September 11 to 12, 2013. This was his first official visit to Pakistan.

On September 12, Vice-Minister Kiuchi visited Mazar-e-Quaid to pay tribute to Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah and laid a floral wreath.
